**2006 Best of the Valley Quilt Show benefited local community**

**TULARE, CA:** There was a bustle of activity at the 2006 Best of the Valley Quilt Show, held April 21-23, 2006 at the International Agri-Center's Heritage Complex in Tulare, Calif.

Over 400 items could be seen at the Quilt Show with special exhibits such as the "Think Pink" Quilt Challenge, a traveling display of tastefully decorated bras (a fundraiser for breast cancer patients), cloth dolls, vendors, and quilts.

"Saturday of the show, we broke our attendance record," said Bobbi Moore, Show Chairman. "And the vendors were really very happy and did quite well financially."

The Quilt Show also presented an "Encouragement in Quilting" Scholarship to 14-year-old Kayla Hamilton of Farmersville, Calif.

"The scholarship is for beginning quilting lessons," explained Moore.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual "Think Pink" Quilt Challenge raised \$745 to benefit breast cancer patients through the American Cancer Society.

The Teviston Quilting Group were honored guests and raffled their quilts at the show.

"They've come along way in the 15 months since I began teaching them new quilting techniques," said Moore of the quilting group that meets at the Teviston Betterment Association, 3 miles south of Pixley, Calif. "And they do beautiful work."
